introduction

Message

***For the Son of Man came to seek and to save
what was lost.***

Luke 19:10

God values lost people. A lost person is someone who sinned against God, someone who is in a wrong direction, away from God. Because of our sin, we were all lost. But we are so valuable to God that's why Jesus came to seek and save us.

In fact, he came to the point of dying on the cross so that we will never be separated from Him again. Because of what Jesus did, we can now enjoy a personal relationship with God, experience forgiveness of sin and live a changed life.

challenge
