Main idea

Come to Jesus, the Author and Source of life.

Warm-up

introduction

Steve Jobs (Chairman and CEO of Apple company; Producer of Mac computers, I-Phone, I-Pod)—gave this speech to the Batch 2005 Graduating class of Stanford University, **“Stay hungry, stay foolish”**. In a nutshell, Steve Jobs was saying, Be a perpetual learner. Never stop learning. I totally agree! We need to learn humbly and learn continually, but we need to make sure we're learning from the right source. That's because the input (source) will determine the output (outcome of our life).

The life we're living today, our perspective in life, decisions and choices we make, how we walk, eat, talk, relate with people, handle our finances, were influenced by our past and current sources (Parents, friends, media, books, magazines, etc). “Who and what you listen to will influence what you do.” That is why it's important to learn from the right source because it will determine the outcome of our life. Question: Who should we listen to?

Message

“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matt. 11:28-30

Jesus said, *“come to me and learn from me.”* Especially those of you are weary & burdened (tired) the same life everyday (boredom), same problem (poverty, struggle); burned-out, drained; about to give up on your dream (of finishing school, recovering from the mess you're in)

Jesus said: *“Come to me and learn from me”*; God knows exactly how to fix your life, He knows exactly what you need in order to get back and have a breakthrough, He knows exactly how to make things work, God has the power to give you a brand new start, because He is the author and source of life.

One day, Henry Ford was driving in the Michigan countryside when he came upon a man whose Model T had broken down. The guy was bent under the hood trying to figure what was wrong. Mr. Ford stopped and asked if he could take a look. In a few minutes, he had the car running. The grateful owner said, *“I'm amazed at your ability; you fixed my car so easily.”* Ford replied, *“I ought to be able to fix it, because I'm the one who designed it.”* The same is true with God—He designed us, he is the Creator. He knows what we need, what's good for us, and how should we live our life.

John 14:6 Jesus answered, *“I am **the way and the truth and the life.** No one comes to the Father except through me.”* You want life? You want to make every second count and live with zero-regret? Learn from the Master, the Source of life, and you will never go wrong. You will live life to the full.
